



Get to Know Me!

Have members team up with someone they are not sitting next to in the meeting. Instruct each duo to take turns asking each other three questions:

Scavenger Hunt

This can be done as individuals or small teams. Hand out a list of items and answers that each team needs to find. The items and answers should all be work-related. Some should be easier than others, but make sure to have some tricky ones in there.

Give a time limit for the teams to find as many answers as possible.

Everyone will be reminded of some important work policies and procedures. This type of learning will last a long time because of the excitement that is paired with it.
