Volunteers of America Feeds 1,500 Families in Need for Thanksgiving

People in need line-up to receive Thanksgiving food baskets to feed their families this holiday

Denver, CO. November 20, 2019 — Volunteers of America will distribute 1,500 Thanksgiving food baskets on Monday, November 25 from 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. at the VOA Mission at 2877 Lawrence St in Denver. Individuals with vouchers to receive a baskets will begin lining up early in the morning and distribution will begin promptly at 9 a.m..

Thanksgiving baskets include a turkey, stuffing, fresh produce, cranberry sauce and all the trimmings for families who otherwise might not be able to afford a Thanksgiving meal. Each basket serves six people and this annual holiday tradition feeds more than 9,000 individuals in need in the Denver area each year.

WHAT: 1,500 Thanksgiving food baskets are distributed to low-income families and individuals who might not have a meal on Thanksgiving.

WHERE: The Volunteers of America Mission, 2877 Lawrence Street, Denver, CO 80205

WHEN: Monday, November 25, 2019. Basket packing is from **9:00 a.m. to 5 p.m.** – the line begins to form around 6 a.m.

Why: Thousands of individuals and families in Denver would not have a meal on Thanksgiving Day if not for the critical partnership of Volunteers of America, Safeway, Food Bank of the Rockies, the Denver Rescue Mission.
