Addressing A Growing Need

in the last decade:

- ▶ The rate of opioid use among women giving birth has **quadrupled**
- ▶ The incidence of neonatal drug withdrawal syndrom (NAS) **grew 5 fold**

Recent reports recognize the necessity of specialized solutions for pregnant and postpartum women to address health disparities. VOA has responded to that need by opening and operating family-focused recovery centers that keep families together.

Expanding Our Recovery Centers

VOA's family-focused recovery centers are expanding rapidly, especially in rural communities. The impact includes:

- Increased employment rate for recovering mothers
- Reduced number of kids placed in foster care
- Reduced rate of NAS births and NICU stays
- Reduced rate of maternal overdoses
- Prevention of HIV and other STIs
- Reduced incarceration rates
